# What every clinical practice should know about the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)

#### **New in 2025: Medicare Part D Changes**

- Out-of-pocket Part D drug costs will be capped at \$2,000.
- The Medicare Prescription Payment Plan is a new (voluntary)
  opt-in member payment option that "smooths" the way for members
  (with Part D prescription drug coverage) to spread out the cost of
  their prescription drugs over the plan year.

## What to do now: Consider your patient's out-of-pocket costs and experience

- Encourage your Independence Blue Cross (IBX) Medicare
  Advantage patients, our members, to consider using preferred
  pharmacies and/or mail order to take advantage of \$0 copays
  on Tier 1 & 2 prescription drugs. Visit our find a pharmacy webpage.
- Write 90-day prescriptions to improve medication adherence.
- Enroll in our <u>PEAR portal</u> and obtain access to the PEAR AR application.
- Review your Part D member-specific Impact Report in PEAR AR, in Output Manager under Published Reports.
- Update prescriptions by changing Non-Formulary medications to formulary and consider lower tier/lower cost options, if available.
- Submit Prior Authorizations or request drug exceptions. Requirements should include a physician statement with details to avoid a denial.
- Tell patients (our members) to contact us with questions using the number on the back of their insurance card.
