Measure Requirements

Children who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during the last 15 months:

- Well-child visits in the first 15 months. Six or more well-child visits that occur with a PCP on different dates of service after 31-days after birth and on or before the child's 15-month birthday.
- Well-child visits for 15 30 months. Two or more well-child visits that occur with a PCP on different dates of service between the child's 15-month birthday plus 1-day and the 30-month birthday.

Each well-child visit should include the following: physical exam, health history, physical developmental history, mental developmental history, and health education/anticipatory guidance.



Member Requirements

Members who were with a practice for 11 consecutive months within the measurement year (2024) and:

- For well-child visits for the first 15 months of life, children who turn 15 months old during the measurement year (2024). Calculate the 15-month birthday as the child's 1st birthday plus 90 days.
- For well-child visits 15 30 months, children who turn 30 months old during the measurement year (2024). Calculate the 30-month birthday as the 2nd birthday plus 180 days.
